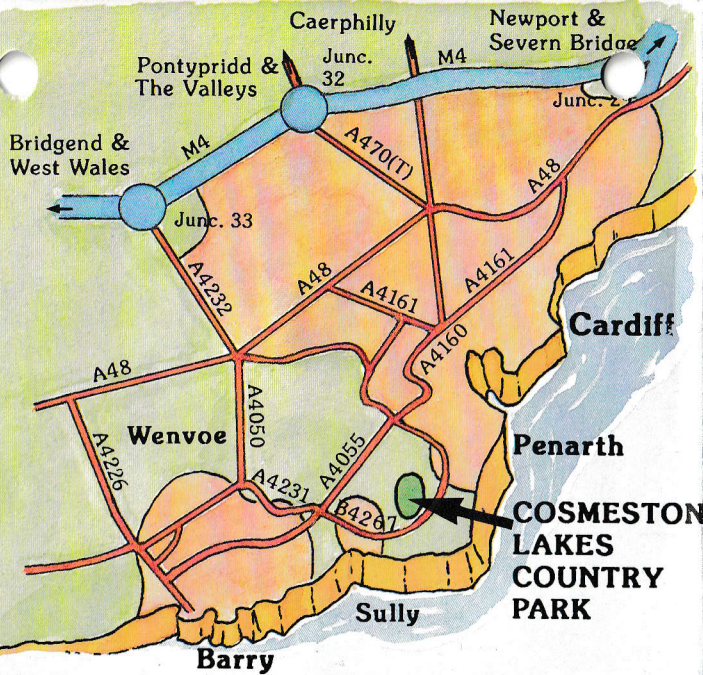


COSMESTON LAKES COUNTRY PARK



How to get there

By Car

Cosmeston Lakes are situated about five miles south of Cardiff. The main entrance is $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles south of Penarth town centre on the B4267 Lavernock Road Sully.

By Bus

Bus stops are situated conveniently near the main entrance to the park. National Welsh provide a regular Bustler service to and from the park. Full details of routes and times can be obtained from National Welsh on Barry (0446) 733236.

On Foot or Bicycle

Pedestrian entrances to Mile End Road can be found at Cogan Hall Farm, Sully Road and Lavernock Road. Access may also be gained from Byrd Crescent, Penarth, and from various points in Penarth via the Railway Walk, which runs to Lavernock Park Estate.
